1. Your friend wants some advice about what to do to get ready for his or her trip to the Central African Republic. Tell your friend what he or she needs to do to get ready. Write a minimum of eight sentences in your note.
2. What will you do during summer vacation under the following condition? Write a note to your friend talking about the possibilities for summer vacation. Don't forget to ask her at least 4 questions about what she is doing or would do. Write at least 10 sentences.
3. Your best friend is on a safari in the Central African Republic. He can't believe some of the things that he is seeing. He left you a short text message on your phone saying what a great trip he's having. Write him a letter asking him about the things he's seeing and doing. Write at least 8 questions.

5. What will you do during summer vacation under the following condition? Write an e-mail to your penpal telling him what you will do IF you find a job. Be sure to ask him 4 questions about his plans too. Write at least 8 sentences.
6. Imagine that your little brother or sister is annoying you. Imagine the kinds of things that (s)he might be doing and your responses. Give at least 6 sentences. Example: You're really bothering me. Stop talking.
7. You're a script writer and you're writing a scene between two friends on a safari. One friend wants to get out of the jeep. The other thinks it's a bad idea, cautions the friend, and expresses fear of what could happen. Write their conversation. You should write at least eight lines.
8. Your parents have chosen your future spouse for you and are giving you no choice in the matter. You're talking about this with your friend. She's giving you advice about what she would do and asking you questions about what you will do if they do change their minds. Write at least 4 questions and 4 sentences.
9. You're writing your own advice column about traveling in the Central African Republic. Imagine the types of questions people might have asked you. Write at least 4 questions that your readers have sent in and give them the best advice for their trip.
10. Write about how your life **would be** different if you lived in Nefta rather than Tunis. Write at least 8 sentences.
11. Imagine that you write your own advice column about traveling. Write the questions your readers have sent in asking you for advice about traveling in the Central African Republic. Since you have a great number of readers, write at least 8 questions.
12. Write about how your life **would be** different if you lived in France rather than in the US. Write at least 8 sentences.
13. Write to the coordinator of the Peace Corps and ask how your life **would be** different if you lived in the savannah rather than the tropical rain forest. Write at least 8 questions.
14. Your sister is on the phone and won't get off, even though you need to call your boss (patron). Write a conversation in which you express your growing frustration with your sister. Write at least 8 good sentences.

15. You're at the movies and the people behind you start talking. Create the dialogue between you and them. You begin by being polite but in the end, you have just had it! Write at least 8 sentences.
16. You're interested in going to a music school. Write a formal letter to the director of the school, M. Meyer, to ask for more information. Ask about the types of classes offered, the times the classes meet, and the cost of the classes. Write at least 5 statements and 5 questions.
17. One of your friends is having problems with his parents regarding his future plans. Write a conversation in which he asks you questions and you respond by offering him advice, telling him different things that you would do in his situation. Write at least 4 questions and responses.
18. Discuss the advantages and/or disadvantages of at least three professions that interest you. Write at least 10 sentences.
19. You're about to finish high school, but you still don't know what you want to do. Write to your pen pal, expressing your indecision. Ask him or her what you should do. Ask at least 4 questions and write at least 4 statements.
20. Your friend wrote you a note suggesting you go to a party with her. Write your reply, saying that you can't go and why. Suggest that you go to the movies instead on a different day and ask about arrangements. Write at least 8 sentences.
21. Your friend's parents have just chosen her husband-to-be. You are curious about the guy and his family. Ask her at least 8 questions about him and his family.
22. You've been living in a big city for the past month and you're very unhappy. Write a letter to your friend back home in the country, complaining about certain aspects of city life.
23. You're studying at a university in a big city, and you miss your friends and family back home in the country. Write a letter to your family, telling how you're doing, complaining about your new life in the city and conveying good wishes to all the people you miss. Write at least 10 sentences. (greetings & closings don't count)
24. Write a friend asking what he would like to do (his wishes and hopes) this summer. . Write at least 8 questions.
25. Your friend is asking you what will you do when you finish high school? Write a letter in which she asks you at least 8 questions about your future.
26. Your pen pal wants to know what your plans are for the summer. You're considering several possibilities if the conditions are right. Write a letter telling your pen pal about the possibilities and conditions.
